

Guidance for Customers using Baildon Golf Club

UPDATED 2/4/21

Welcome to Baildon Golf club. Before using our facilities, please ensure you can comply with the following requirements.

- From 29 March, the 'stay at home' rule ended - and up in a group of up to 6 from any number of households (children of all ages count towards the limit of 6)
- in a group of any size from up to two households (each household can include an existing support bubble, if eligible)

. Shielding ends on 31 March.

If you or any member of your family group has COVID symptoms you cannot visit the premises.

You must wear a mask when entering or moving around the clubhouse.

You should maintain social distancing rules.

Anybody playing golf must register their details for the purposes of track and trace. This information will be held by us for 21 days and provided to NHS Test and Trace if required.

If you meet outside in a group of 6 you cannot move to another group.

The clubhouse will remain closed until 12th April

Members & Visitors should only arrive no earlier than 20 minutes prior to their tee time to enable social distancing

2 metres of social distancing must be observed at all times, in the Car Park, around the Clubhouse and on the Course.

Only players with tee times are allowed on property.

No play without a pre-booked tee time is allowed.

No more than one group may congregate on any tee box.

From 12th April

- Hospitality venues can serve people outdoors only. There will be no need for customers to order a substantial meal with alcohol, and no curfew - although customers must order, eat and drink while seated.

If you or any member of your family group has COVID symptoms you cannot visit the premises.

Please don't move tables or chairs.

You must clean your hands when entering using the hand sanitizer provided.

You must wear a mask when entering or moving around the clubhouse.

Follow the guidance for use of toilet facilities.

You should maintain social distancing rules.

You should stay with the group you played golf.

Anybody playing golf must register their details for the purposes of track and trace.

Please make payments by your club card or contactless payment system if possible.

From 17th May

- Indoor hospitality, entertainment venues such as cinemas and soft play areas, the rest of the accommodation sector, and indoor adult group sports and exercise classes will also reopen.

If you or any member of your family group has COVID symptoms you cannot visit the premises.

A maximum of 30 people are allowed to gather outside.

Inside the rule of 6 applies. A maximum of 6 people or 2 households can sit together.

Please don't move tables or chairs.

Please follow all instructions from our staff. You must sit down and wait to be served. You MUST provide full names and contact details for you and your family group to gain entry. This information will be held by us for 21 days and provided to NHS Test and Trace if required. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in service being denied.

Parents with Children must keep them at their table and ensure they follow the social distancing requirements.

If you are seated outside and the weather deteriorates you will not be allowed inside unless there is spare capacity.

Do not socialize with other households or individuals indoors.

Please make payments by your club card or contactless payment system if possible.
